February 17, 2009 Regular Meeting

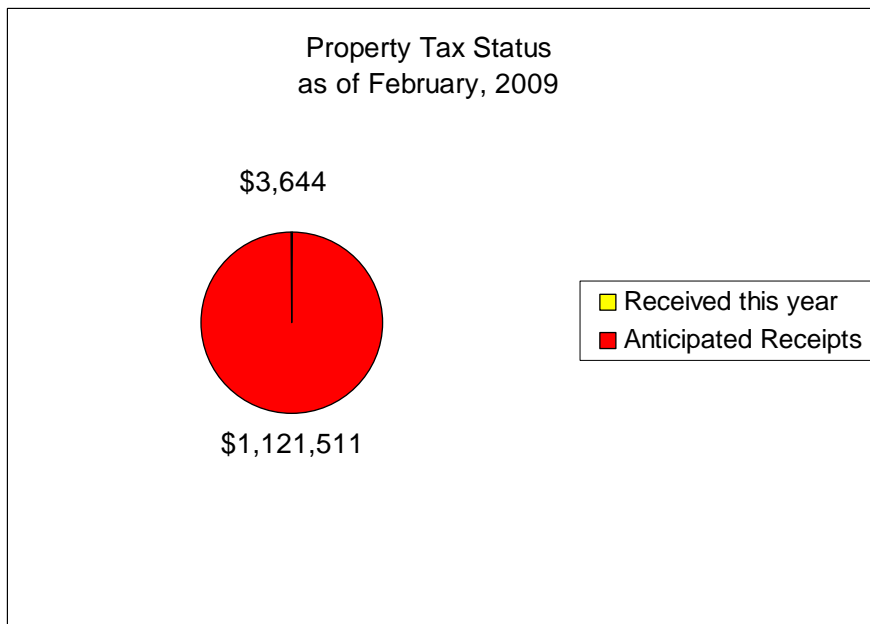

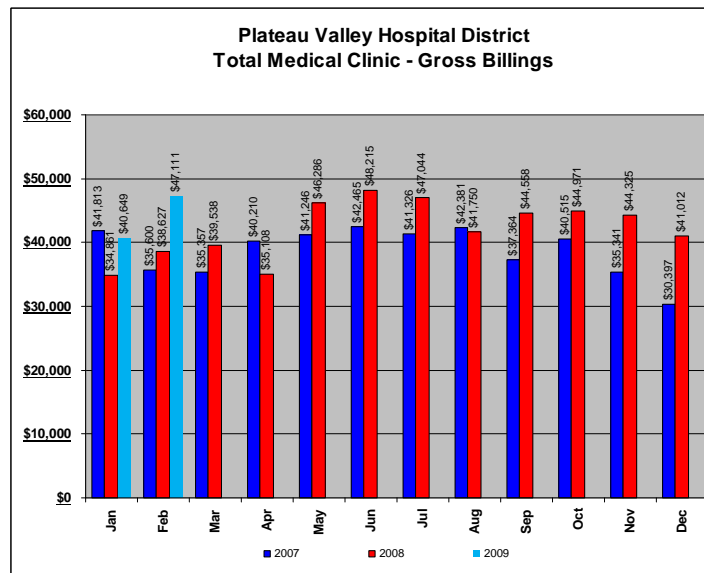
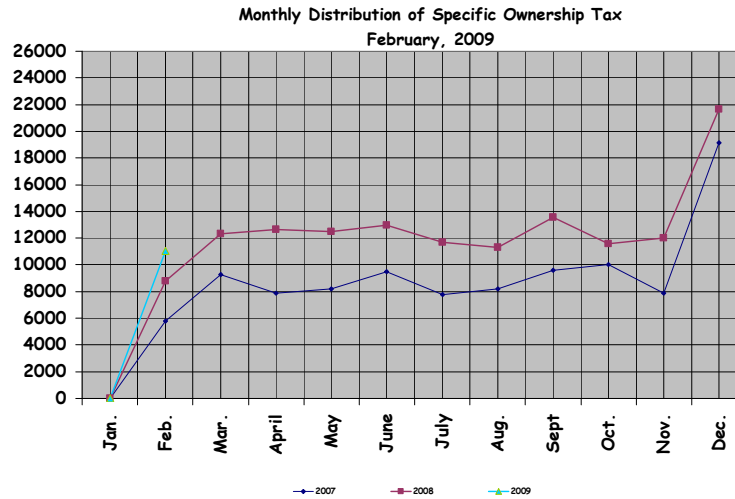
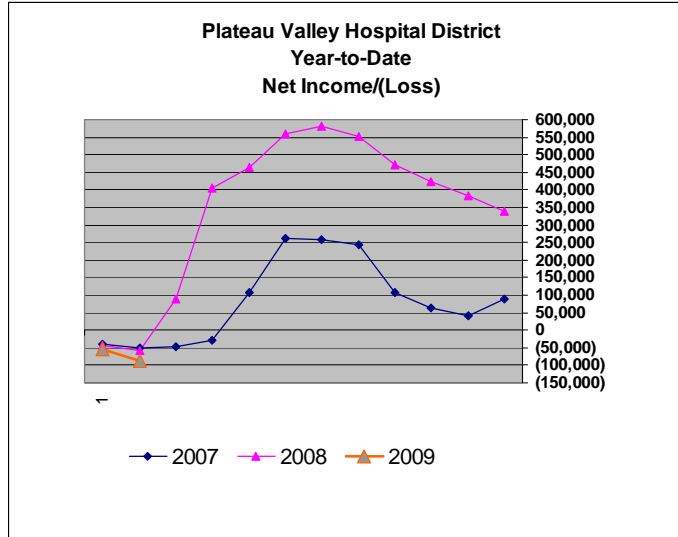
2. CLINIC CONSULTANT REPORT

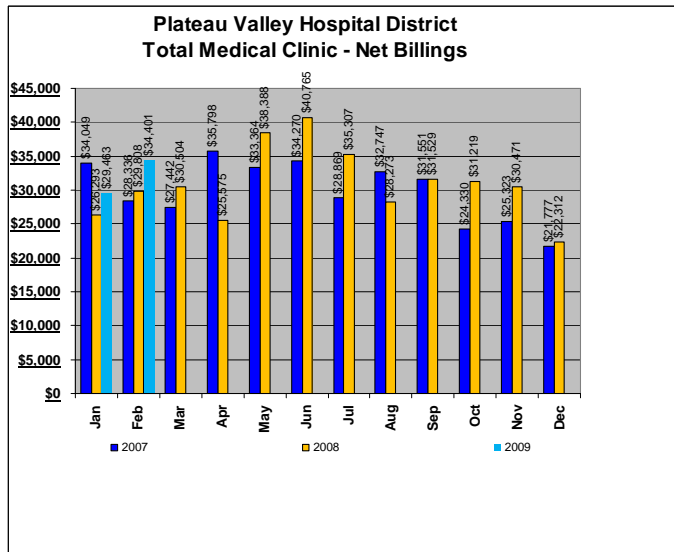
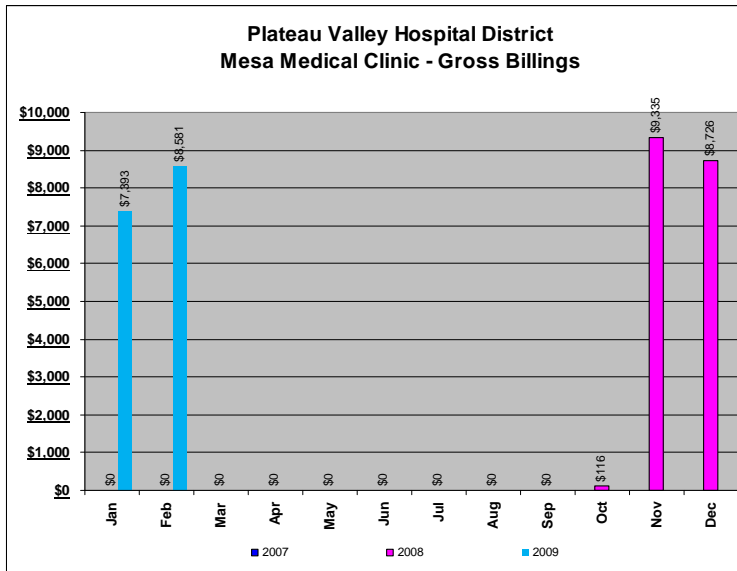
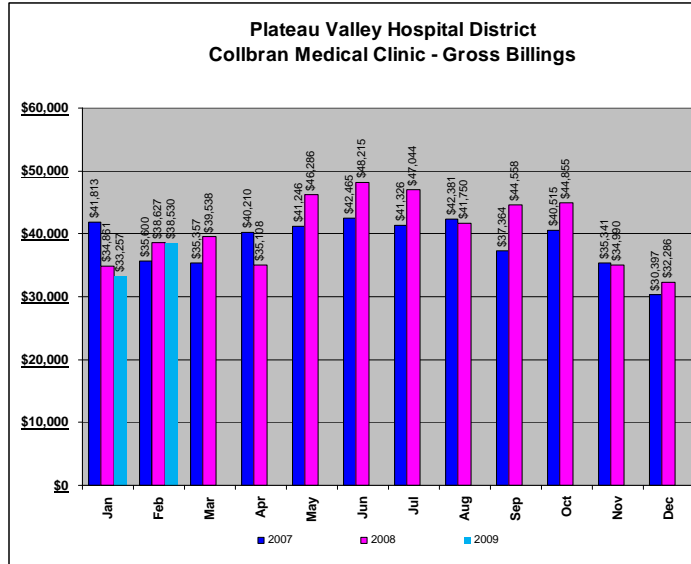

There was discussion of what this means for long-term planning and future grant needs. Shannon will do a cash flow analysis for the next meeting.

- **Resolution 2:** Be it resolved that the accounts payable & payroll checks (#46653-46705) are approved. Denny Holmes motioned and Frank Wagner seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- **Resolution 3:** Be it resolved that the Board of Directors approves the February write-offs in the amount of \$12,710.21. Denny Holmes motioned and Frank Wagner seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

5. OLD BUSINESS

- Noise at Mesa building – It was decided that there is still sound being carried from room to room. We will try music to see if that helps and if so, look at purchasing a system.

- Break periods - Jessi contacted our attorney and as long as we continue to authorize and permit breaks then we are compliant.
- Physician contracts – Jessi spoke with the attorney, who suggested many changes. Jessi will contract her again and find out the cost of the attorney reworking the contract versus us doing it ourselves with the attorney reviewing it. Jessi will also check on the timeframes for both options.
- **Resolution 4:** Be it resolved that the Board of Directors approves using the attorney to either write the new physician contracts or review them. Denny Holmes motioned and Frank Wagner seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- Wage Scale – Dave presented two options for a wage scale, a stepped table and a percentage table. It was decided to create a stepped wage scale with a merit based increase as well. Dave will rework this and present at the next Board Meeting.

6. NEW BUSINESS

- The Plateau Valley School Robotics Team – The team would like to set a donation jar at our front desk. There was discussion of whether this would open us up to having to allow donation jars for anyone who asks. It was decided not to allow the donation jar, but make a donation instead.
- **Resolution 5:** Be it resolved that the Board of Directors approves a \$200 donation to the Plateau Valley High School Robotics Team. Frank Wagner motioned and Denny Holmes seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- Tdap vaccine – It has been recommended that healthcare workers who have not had a tetnus booster in the last two years should receive a booster now with the pertussis component in it. It was decided to offer this to our employees.

Should the grant budget for our site be reduced, our proposed match is also reduced so that it remains 52% of the grant budget for our site in the application. Denny Holmes motioned and Frank Wagner seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- **Resolution7:** Be it resolved that the Board of Directors to resolve to contract with the Federal Government as it relates to the USDA Rural Development FY2009 Distance Learning and Telemedicine Grant Program. Denny Holmes motioned and Dave Bristol seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
